What will I get out of the Roundtable session?

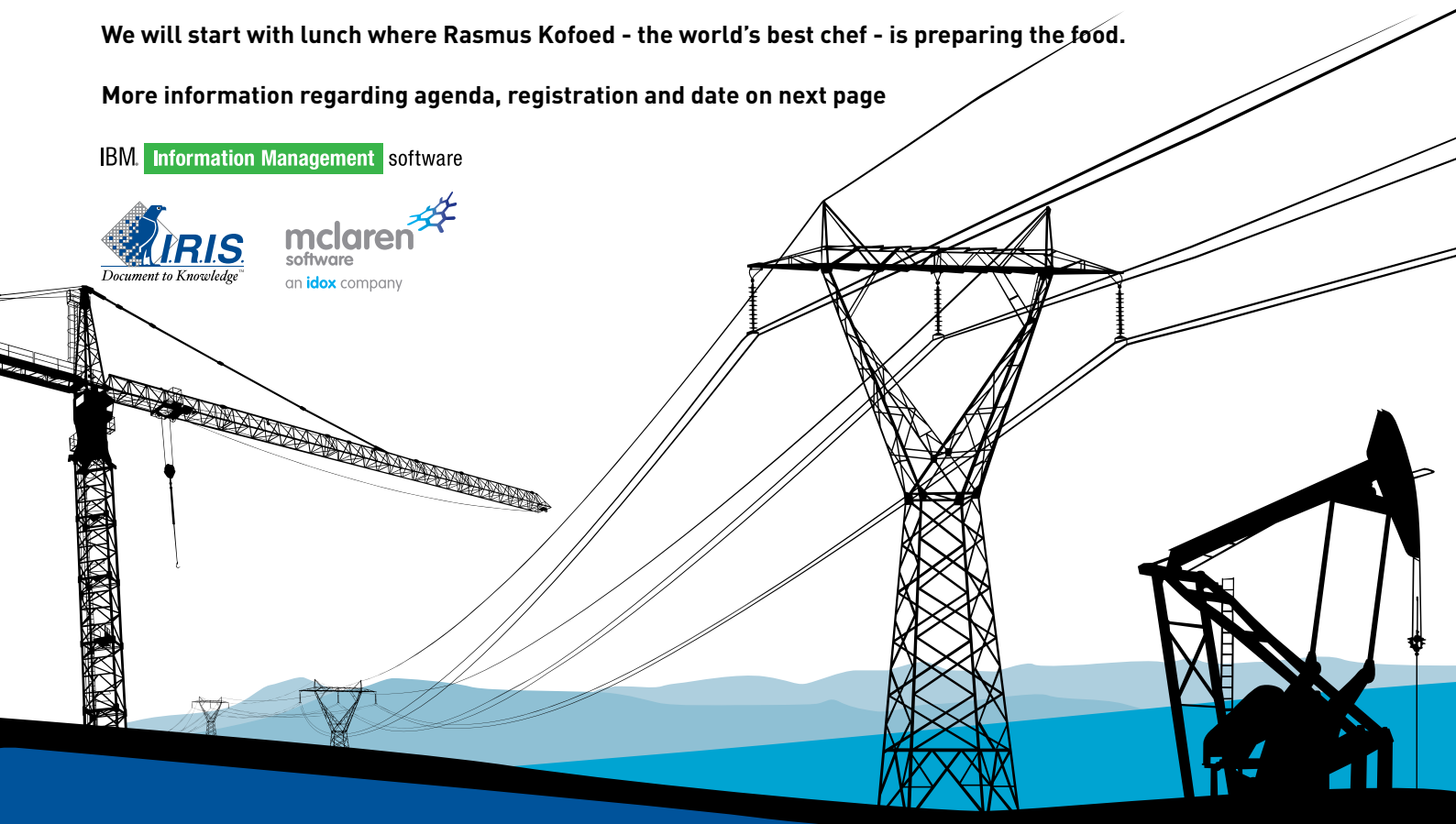
